

The Committee on the Homeless at its April 20, 2016 meeting passed the following two motions:

1. Motion - For the Commission to support the installation of portable showers for the use of the homeless throughout the City as a means of encouraging the homeless to seek services and supports.

**Motion made by:** Gail Harris; **Seconded by:** Donna Zemo. Adopted unanimously by voice vote.

2. Motion: The Committee on the Homeless recommends that the Mayor and Commission explore limiting package store alcohol sales to no earlier than 10:00am.

**Motion made by:** Lori Bakkum; **Seconded by** Freddy Funes. Adopted 6 - 1 by voice vote.

The Committee on the Homeless at its May 18, 2016 meeting passed the following motion:

1. For the Commission to consider the installation of the PIT Stop Program throughout the City of Miami Beach. The PIT Stop Program provides clean and safe portable public toilets, sinks, used needle receptacles and dog waste stations.

**Motion made by:** Donna Zemo; **Seconded by** Gail Harris. Adopted unanimously by voice vote.
